East Sussex County Council budget 2013-2014

As in my November report, East Sussex County Council agreed that no increase in Council Tax in 2013/14 and an estimated savings of £60m needed to be produced over the next three years.

The first East Sussex County Council savings proposal workshop held in December; I attended the workshop for transport & environment and community department. I am pleased to report that County Highways is retain the current standard service, and Polegate and Willingdon library will be remain open as normal. The mobile library services are under reviews, a public consultation survey's report is going to the next community committee for discussion.

The next East Sussex County Council savings proposal workshop will takes place in 22nd January.
