Polegate and Willingdon County Councillor Stephen Shing report

A259 & A22 IMPROVEMENT

You may be interested to know that, as a result of the existing crash records on both roads, the County Council has identified the A259 between Friston and Seaford and the A22 between Cophall Roundabout and Boship Roundabout as two routes requiring attention. They are currently working on these studies and it is the County Council's intention to implement some improvements to the signing and lining on these routes to assist in improving road safety.

ROAD MARKINGS - Hailsham Road / Cophall Roundabout

Before Christmas, a number of residents reported to us about the non-existent road markings at the junction of Hailsham Road / Cophall Roundabout.

We have had a number of discussions with East Sussex County Council's Highways Team and the Highways Agency over the straight forward exercise to renew the road markings, however, the situation is complicated between the two authorities. The County Highways have since erected a temporary "No Road Markings" road sign and will work on the new road markings once weather conditions become less wet and are suitable.
