<b>12134</b>	<b>CCTV</b> The committee discussed the options and the potential benefits of one and possibly a second free camera. A Councillor stated that it would mean the council were guaranteeing residents that CCTV would be in place for five years. The committee discussed the numbers of authorities and private companies in the partnership. Option 2 was discussed (removing one camera, and dismissed as council had already resolved to continue with the CCTV. Option 4 was recommended and discussed in full and all agreed this was by far the best option for the town as it could save £7395 and possible £14,790 on the costs of the cameras. <b>It was resolved to select option 4 which is to sign up to a 5 year contract and make a bid for two cameras as pre the background papers.</b> <b>VOTE All in favour Cllrs D Watts, Ms A Snell, D Dunbar, Mrs M Piper, S Shing, M Falkner, B Goodwin</b>
