12280	Payments as presented for approval A Councillor asked what the payment for the electrical works was at the High Street toilets, the clerk replied that it was the remedial works following the periodical electrical test. 12281	Contracts <i>Cllr S Shing arrived at 9.53 am</i> <i>Cllr D Dunbar arrived at 9.57 am</i> a) Grass Cutting The committee discussed at length the issues around both grass cutting and grounds maintenance contracts. They also discussed the values of the contracts which may increase and the likelihood of East Sussex Highways reducing cuts over time. It was agreed that although it may be better to hand over to East Sussex Highways, at this stage without details on the price per cut that was not possible. It was agreed to defer that decision until the prices were known. It was resolved to award the grass cutting contract to Tim Jordan for one year. VOTE 5 for Cllrs D Murray, Ms A Snell (ex officio), D Watts, Mrs M Piper, D Dunbar 1 abstention Cllr S Shing.

b) Grounds Maintenance

A discussion on the merits and pitfalls of having a 5 years contract were discussed by the committee. The committee were satisfied that with appropriate contract monitoring the contract over 5 years was preferable.

It was resolved to select Tim Jordan for the grounds maintenance contract for a 5 year contract as per the paperwork. VOTE All in favour Cllrs D Murray, Ms A Snell, D Watts, Mrs M Piper, S Shing D Dunbar
