c) Whether to go ahead with the smaller age gym

A councillor asked would that mean there would be \$106 money left over. The clerk stated that there was a lot of funding, but that the council would only be given what could be used for the age gym (submitted items). A councillor asked if the other money could be used for another play area. The clerk stated that it could but that it must be on adult and youth play space. The clerk gave examples of age gym, trim trails and similar items. Another councillor asked if that could be used on equipment for older children. The clerk stated that it could be used for that, but that the park was restricted on age entrance to prevent anti social behaviour in the park.

A councillor asked if there was any money left over form the S106 money, could this be spent on keeping the toilets open. The clerk stated that it could not as the money was earmarked for adult and youth play space only.

It was agreed that the S106 money would be used and the gym would be the best value as per the quotations VOTE All in favour FOR Clirs T Voyce, J Voyce, Mrs M Piper, M Clewett

d) The number of pieces of equipment as shown in the quote

It was agreed that subject to the best contractor being sought the committee would select the highest number that was within budget from the contractor. This would be added to an agenda to discuss the quotes and the contractors in confidential session. VOTE All in favour FOR Cllrs T Voyce, J Voyce, Mrs M Piper, M Clewett

e) The location of the pieces of equipment at Polegate War Memorial Recreation Ground

The committee had individually had a look at the site and agreed that the best location was that given by the contractors. Subject the health and safety the location would be behind the football pitch towards the Wannock drive fence near to the garage/play area. This was slightly offset from the goal area.

A councillor asked if new quotes would be required. The clerk stated that all of the quotes were very similar in price and that once a contractor and the equipment was discussed then final prices could be gathered/negotiated.

A councillor asked how long it was likely to take before installation. The clerk stated that once a decision had been made by council it was likely that it could be done quite quickly, the lead in time was not substantial (around 6 weeks) but would be weather dependent and probably would go ahead in Spring or early summer if it was resolved, subject to funds from the district council.
