7887 Apologies for absence

Apologies were received from Cllrs. G. Carter, J. Harmer and Mrs J. Voyce.

7888 Declarations of interest

Cllrs. Mrs Piper and J. Rogers declared a personal interest in application no WD/2008/0149/0: 1, Northfield, Polegate.

STANDING ORDERS SUSPENDED

Two members of the public spoke to voice opposition to the application WD/2008/0149/0 – 1 Northfield. In summary their comments are:

1. If further development is allowed in this area then it would change in nature from medium density to high density
2. The different elevations of this development would mean that it no longer corresponded to the existing natural building line
3. There is the possibility of flooding to the site in view of its close proximity to the brook

4. If developments such as this are allowed to continue it will seriously affect the character of the town
5. There are concerns from neighbours regarding the proposed height of the development

Erection of single storey private dwelling with vehicular access on to Wannock Road.

2. Gradients to access road unacceptable
3. Overdevelopment of constrained site which fails to achieve satisfactory living environment for future occupiers of the property
4. Would impact upon views towards AONB
