When and where can I travel on the bus?

The bus runs between 9.00 am and 4.00 pm on Tuesdays and Fridays except on Bank Holidays.

On Tuesdays the Community Bus will take you to and from anywhere within the Polegate and Willingdon area. You can also travel to Sainsbury's at Broadwater Way in Hampden Park, to the District General Hospital in Kings' Drive or Eastbourne Town Centre.

On Fridays the bus will take you to and from anywhere in the wider Eastbourne and Polegate area.

Where does the bus pick me up?

We offer a truly personal service by providing door to door transport (subject to access

Freedom to do what you want ...

You can use the bus to go shopping, visit your Doctor, Dentist or Optician, go to the cinema or the pub, visit friends and family in fact almost anything provided it is within the designated area of travel for that day.

Pick up times and route information are available from the CTLA office. We try to be as flexible as possible but please bear in mind the service you require may be shared with other users.

How do I book this service?

You can call our offices and talk to our friendly helpful staff between 9.00 am and 3.00 pm on Mondays to Fridays. Bookings can be taken a maximum of two weeks in advance. Please try to book your journey at least one day before you travel, although we will do our best to fit you in on the same day. Please understand we cannot promise the bus will be available for the exact time requested but we will always do our best to help.

Can I take my wheelchair or walking aid?

Yes, all of our vehicles are fully accessible by either ramp or tail-lift, when booking please inform us if you are a wheelchair user or you use a walking frame.

We can also accommodate families with folding buggies.

How much does it cost?

There is a flat fare of £2.50 per person for each single journey you make (£5.00 Return)

Children under 16 years of age accompanied by an adult travel free of charge .

Unfortunately the National Concessionary Bus Pass cannot be accepted on this service.

Two's Company - One Fare

Take a partner or a friend and only pay for one when you travel together, provided you board and alight at the same points.
