For a small charge plus the cost of the materials, the Handymen can carry out the small repair jobs, fit security locks, improve access to and from your property, fit hand rails and grab rails, put up curtains, carry out small plumbing jobs, repair fencing and fit and supply keysafes, carbon monoxide detectors, small decorating and gardening jobs.
